solemnly and sincerely affirm as follows:

1. I oppose the Rotorua District Council's decision on 19 November 2021 to seek statutory reform through parliament for this year's local government elections and in particular I oppose the Rotorua District Council (Representation Arrangements) Bill.
2. I believe that Rotorua local government elections should comply with the Local Electoral Act 2001 and be a free and democratic election in accordance with the principle of equal suffrage, rather than so called "voter parity".
3. I have little confidence in the Rotorua District Council's decision-making processes.
4. I have read the Statement of Claim filed by Mr Robert Lee on 29 April 2022 which asks that the decision by the Rotorua District Council to seek statutory reform for representation arrangements at this year's local government elections be set aside.
